Description of content: This regulation amends the Regulation of the Minister of Agriculture No. 139/Permentan/PD.410/12/2014 concerning Importation of Carcasses, Meat and/or Its Processed Products Into the Territory of the Republic of Indonesia. This amendment is necessary in order to address conditions related to food supply, price volatility and/or emergency circumstances. The amendments of the revised regulation are as follows: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. There are new provisions regarding the importation of carcasses and/or secondary cuts by the State-Owned Enterprises to address conditions linked to the food supply, price volatility, inflation and/or natural disasters (Article 23, paragraph 3).2. The intended use of beef for hotels, restaurants, catering, industrial and other special purposes imported by the State-Owned Enterprises are to stabilize prices through market operations and disaster support (Article 32, paragraph 4).3. Business communities, the State-Owned Enterprises, Regional Enterprises, Social Institutions, and Foreign State Representative/International Institutions which import carcasses, meat and/or its processed products shall report the realization of prior period importation when applying for a new recommendation in accordance with the Format-4 (Article 33, point d). Other provisions stipulated in the Regulation of the Minister of Agriculture No. 139/Permentan/PD.410/12/2014 concerning Importation of Carcasses, Meat and/or Its Processed Products Into the Territory of the Republic of Indonesia still remain valid.
