Description of content:</b>  This regulation is the amendment of The Regulation of Minister of Agriculture No. 18/Permentan/OT.140/2/2008 concerning Plant Quarantine Requirements and Actions for the Importation of Fresh Plant Product in the Form of Fresh Bulb Vegetables into The Territory of The Republic of Indonesia  This regulation stipulates designated points of entry for fresh fruits and/or fruit vegetables. By the stipulation of this regulation, the importation of fresh fruits and/or fruit vegetables shall only be imported through:  a. Tanjung Perak Seaport, Surabaya; b. Belawan Seaport, Medan; c. Soekarno-Hatta Seaport, Makassar; and d. Soekarno-Hatta International Airport, Jakarta.
