<p>6. <b>Description of content:</b> This regulation is a further arrangement of Article 5 of Government Regulation No. 15 of 2002 concerning Fish Quarantine that has been previously notified.</p> <p>This regulation covers additional obligations, other than predetermined fish quarantine requirements, for importation of carrier into the Territory of the Republic of Indonesia. As used in this regulation:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Carrier means fish and/or other material capable of carrying Quarantine Pests and Diseases of Fish (QPDF) and/or Certain Pests and Disease of Fish (PDF).</li></ul> <p>This regulation specifies as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Carrier that originated from country which is not free from QPDF and/or Certain PDF, shall comply with additional obligations as follow:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>a. Letter of statement from the competent institution stating that:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Country of origin has a disease management program; and</li><li>2. The carrier originated from a zone that is free from QPDF and Certain PDF for the last 2 (two) years based on surveillance.</li></ul></li><li>b. Report of laboratory test issued by an accredited laboratory stating that the carrier has been screened and tested for QPDF or Certain PDF in the country of origin.</li></ul></li><li>- Carrier that is an intermediate host or carrier of QPDF or Certain PDF, shall comply with additional obligations in the form of report of test result issued by an accredited laboratory stating that the carrier has been subjected to QPDF and Certain PDF screening in the country of origin.</li><li>- Carrier that makes a transit in a country which is not free from QPDF and/or Certain PDF, shall comply with additional obligations in the form of prohibition of carrier unloading from the means of conveyance which is proved by Bill of Loading.</li></ul>

<p>– Carrier that is an object of import risk analysis of fish and fishery products, shall comply with additional obligations in accordance with the Result of Import Risk Analysis of Fish and Fishery Products. The object of import risk analysis of fish and fishery products originated from OIE non-member countries includes fish, and/or fishery products. The object of import risk analysis of fish and fishery products originated from OIE member countries includes: a) a new species or strain/variety of fish; b) a new kind of fishery product; c) hazardous fish; d) fish and fishery product originated from a country with a new fish diseases; and/or e) fish and fishery product originated from a country with an epidemic exposure.</p>
