5. Title of the notified document: Import prohibition of live poultry and poultry products from Germany, Netherlands and United Kingdom into the territory of Republic of Indonesia due to outbreak of HPAI H5N8 Language(s): Indonesian Number of pages: 3
6. Description of content: Following the current outbreak of HPAI H5N8 in Germany, the Netherlands and the United Kingdom, the Indonesian Government is taking urgent measures to prohibit the importation of live poultry and poultry products from Germany, the Netherlands and the United Kingdom into the territory of the Republic of Indonesia which might be carriers of HPAI H5N8 that is not existent in Indonesia. This prohibition is based on the risk assessment on the importation of several commodities from the three countries mentioned above, and referred to in the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code Article 10.4.11, OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code Article 10.4.19 and OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code Article 10.4.20. The prohibited commodities are day old chickens (DOC), day old ducks (DOD) and other live poultry (chickens, ornamental birds, and chirping birds).

Nature of the urgent problem(s) and reason for urgent action: Due to the risk of the transmission of the HPAI H5N8 agent to animals and humans through infected live poultry and poultry products, the Government of Indonesia has imposed the prohibition on the importation of live poultry and poultry products from Germany, the Netherlands, and the United Kingdom. This emergency action is necessary to prevent the introduction of HPAI H5N8 that is not existent in Indonesia.
