FOR THE IMPORTATION OF TIMBER PRODUCTS INTO THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA**

| Certification Requirements | Phytosanitary Certificate issued by NPPO exporting country required |
| Prohibited Importations | |
| Bark | Free from bark |
| Pests | Free from Indonesian pest concern |
| Growing medium | Free from soil, clay, compost, sand, peat and spaghnum moss. |
| Pre-shipment Inspection | NOT required or based on agreement between both country |
| Approved Pre-shipment Treatment | Fumigation or heat treatment offshore and stated in the treatment column in PC, as bellow: |
| Fumigation | Methyl bromide (MBr) at 48 g/m ³ for 24 hours at minimum temperature 21°C or above |
| Heat Treatment | Heat treatment at minimum core temperature of wood at 56°C for at least 30 minutes |
| General | Quarantine inspection on arrival in Indonesia |
| Point of Entry | Through the designated point of entry as mentioned in Regulation of Ministry of Agriculture No. 44/Permentan/OT.140/3/2014 (http://perundangan.pertanian.go.id/admin/file/PERMENTAN%2044-2014.pdf) |

| Pesticide | Spraying pesticide as approved by NPPO of the exporting country |
| General | Quarantine inspection on arrival in Indonesia |
| Point of Entry | Through the designated point of entry as mentioned in Regulation of Ministry of Agriculture No. 44/Permentan/OT.140/3/2014 (http://perundangan.pertanian.go.id/admin/file/PERMENTAN%2044-2014.pdf) |
