Description of content: Following an outbreak of Foot-and-Mouth Disease (FMD) among live pigs which was confirmed in South Korea by the OIE on 6 May 2002, the Indonesian Government is taking urgent measures to prohibit importation of animals, animal products and other commodities which might be possible media for transmission of the FMD virus from South Korea for consignments as from 24 April 2002. This temporary action will be withdrawn dependent on the FMD situation in South Korea.
