4.	Title and number of pages of the notified document: Draft of Government Regulation on Trading of Fresh Fruits and Vegetables
5.	Description of content: The regulation contains implementation of Codex Standard on Limitation of Pesticide Residue of fruits and vegetables. The Regulation will be carried out through certification; control will be based on reaudit system. Certificates should be issued by accredited recognized body or body authorized by the government in the country of origin or issued by the Indonesian laboratory. Certificates which are issued by the country of origin will be reaudited (retested) randomly by Indonesian laboratory. In case imported fresh fruits and fresh vegetables are not accompanied by a certificate, a certain time length is still permitted for a certificate to be issued by the country of origin or otherwise a certificate can be issued by an Indonesian laboratory. The implementation of the regulation shall be carried out gradually. For the first stage it will be applied to apples, pears, oranges and grapes. The regulation is also applicable to the same fruits and vegetables produced domestically.
6.	Objective and rationale: Protection of consumer health and safety in relation to excessive (maximum tolerance of) pesticide residue. Its main objective is to protect consumers from poisoning materials.
