Title, language and number of pages of the notified document: Decree of Director General of Livestock Services, Ministry of Agriculture No. 97/Kpts/PD.630/F/08/2007 concerning the Amendment of the Decree of Director General of Livestock Services, Ministry of Agriculture No. 92/Kpts/PD.630/F/08/2007 concerning temporary suspension of live animals, animal products and their derivatives, raw material for animal feed, feedstuff, machinery and equipment and veterinary drugs from United Kingdom into Indonesia (available in English, 5 pages)
6.	Description of content: This Decree stipulates that the importation of live animals, animal products and their derivatives, raw material for animal feed, feedstuff, machinery and equipment and veterinary drugs are permitted to enter into Indonesia if they had been loaded before 3 August 2007. This Decree also stipulates that the importation of live animals, animal products and their derivatives, raw material for animal feed, feedstuff, machinery and equipment and veterinary drugs from other countries which transit in the United Kingdom could be considered after meeting the approval from the Directorate General of Livestock in accordance with the effective stipulation.
7.	Objective and rationale: [] food safety, [X] animal health, [] plant protection, [] protect humans from animal/plant pest or disease, [X] protect territory from other damage from pests

Nature of the urgent problem(s) and reason for urgent action: The current FMD outbreak has led the Government of Indonesia to consider the importation of these products from other countries which transit in the United Kingdom. This emergency action is necessary to prevent the introduction of FMD into Indonesia.
