6.	<b>Description of content:</b> The regulation covered the type and maximum level of microbial and chemical contaminant in food, as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Microbial contaminant: Total Plate Count (TPC), Coliform, <i>Escherichia coli</i>, <i>Salmonella sp</i>, <i>Staphylococcus aureus</i>, <i>Bacillus cereus</i>, fungi, yeasts, <i>Clostridium perfringens</i>, <i>Listeria monocytogenes</i>, <i>Vibrio cholerae</i>, <i>Enterobacteriaceae</i>, and <i>Enterobacter sakazakii</i>.</li><li>- Chemical contaminant:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Heavy metals: arsenic, cadmium, merkuri, tin, and lead</li><li>• Mycotoxins: aflatoxin, deoxynivalenol, Fumonisin B1 + B2, ochratoxin A, patulin</li><li>• Other chemical contaminant: benzo [a] pyrene, dioxin (2,3,7,8-TCDD), 1,3-dichlororopropane-2-ol (1,3-DCP), 3-monochloropropane-1, 2-diol ( 3-MCPD)</li></ul></li></ul>
