Description of content:</b> <p>This regulation is the amendment of The Regulation of Minister of Agriculture No. 90/Permentan/OT.140/12/2011 concerning the Amendment of The Regulation of Minister of Agriculture No. 18/Permentan/OT.140/2/2008 concerning the Amendment of The Regulation of Minister of Agriculture No. 18/Permentan/OT.140/2/2008 concerning Plant Quarantine Requirements and Actions for the Importation of Fresh Plant Products in the Form of Fresh Bulb Vegetables into The Territory of The Republic of Indonesia</p> <p>This regulation stipulates:</p> <p>a. Designated points of entry for fresh bulb vegetables. The importation of fresh bulb vegetables shall only be imported through:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Tanjung Perak Seaport, Surabaya;</li><li>• Belawan Seaport, Medan;</li><li>• Soekarno-Hatta Seaport, Makassar; and</li><li>• Soekarno-Hatta International Airport, Jakarta.</li></ul>

<p>b. Entry points designated as free port under the legislation in the field of free trade zone and free port can be used as entry points for fresh bulb vegetables.</p> <p>c. Suspend the implementation of the Regulation of the Ministry of Agriculture No. 90/Permentan/OT.140/12/2011 which was originally effective on 19 March 2012 to 19 June 2012.</p>
