Description of content:</b>  This regulation is the amendment of The Regulation of Minister of Agriculture No. 37/Kpts/HK.060/1/2006 concerning Technical Requirements and Plant Quarantine Action for the Importation of Fresh Fruits and/or Fruit Vegetables into The Territory of The Republic of Indonesia.  This regulation stipulates designated points of entry for fresh fruits and/or fruit vegetables. By the stipulation of this regulation, the importation of fresh fruits and/or fruit vegetables shall only be imported through:  a. Tanjung Perak Seaport, Surabaya; b. Belawan Seaport, Medan; c. Soekarno-Hatta Seaport, Makassar; and d. Soekarno-Hatta International Airport, Jakarta.
