<b>6. Description of content:</b> This Regulation is amendment of the Regulation of the Minister of Agriculture No. 18/Permentan/OT.140/2/2008 jis the Regulation of the Minister of Agriculture No. 90/Permentan/OT.140/12/2011 jis the Regulation of the Minister of Agriculture No. 16/Permentan/OT.140/3/2012 concerning Plant Quarantine Actions for the Importation of Fresh Plant Product in the Form of Fresh Bulb Vegetables into the Territory of the Republic of Indonesia.  This regulation covers quarantine requirements for the importation of fresh plant products in the form of fresh bulb vegetables, quarantine actions, and designated points of entry.  This regulation specifies as follows:  - Fresh plant products in the form of fresh bulb vegetables imported into Indonesia shall be (i) accompanied by Phytosanitary Certificate from country of origin and/or transit country; (ii) through the designated points of entry; and (iii) notified and submitted to Plant Quarantine Officers at the designated points of entry for plant quarantine actions.  - Fresh plant products in the form of fresh bulb vegetables can be imported into Indonesia from production area in the country of origin that is free from plant quarantine pest as determined in the Decree of the Director General of Indonesian Agricultural Quarantine on behalf of the Ministry of Agriculture, or from production area in the country of origin that is not free from plant quarantine pest.

- Fresh plant products in the form of fresh bulb vegetables imported into Indonesia from production area in the country of origin that is free from plant quarantine pest shall be declared in the Additional Declaration on the accompanied Phytosanitary Certificate, and it has been devitalized and free from particles of soil/compost.

- Fresh plant products in the form of fresh bulb vegetables imported into Indonesia from production area in the country of origin that is not free from plant quarantine pest, shall be treated by fumigation or irradiation treatment, shall be declared in the Additional Declaration on the accompanied Phytosanitary Certificate, and it has been devitalized and free from particles of soil/compost.

- The importation of fresh plant products in the form of fresh bulb vegetables into Indonesia shall only be imported through: (i) Tanjung Perak Seaport, Surabaya; (ii) Belawan Seaport, Medan; (iii) Soekarno-Hatta Seaport, Makasar; and (iv) Soekarno-Hatta Airport, Jakarta.

- Entry points designated as free port under the legislation of Free Trade Zone and Free Port can be used as entry points for fresh plant products in the form of fresh bulb vegetables. This can be done only to meet local consumption need and not allowed to distribute to the outside of Free Trade Zone and Free Port.

- Provision of the designated entry points is not applicable for fresh plant products in the form of fresh bulb vegetables that come from designated pest free production area in the country of origin or from country where its food safety system has been recognized.

By the stipulation of this regulation, the Regulation of the Minister of Agriculture No. 18/Permentan/OT.140/2/2008 jis the Regulation of the Minister of Agriculture No. 90/Permentan/OT.140/12/2011 jis the Regulation of the Minister of Agriculture No. 16/Permentan/OT.140/3/2012 concerning Plant Quarantine Measures for the Importation of Fresh Plant Product in the Form of Fresh Bulb Vegetables into the Territory of the Republic of Indonesia are no longer effective.
