Description of content:</b> Recommendation on approval for the import and export of livestock into and from the territory of the Republic of Indonesia is conducted with some provision as follows: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Importation of slaughter livestock would be proceed to:<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>a. fulfill domestic demand on slaughter cattle;</li><li>b. fulfill specific cut meat demand of domestic market, and;</li><li>c. increase the added value of the imported cattle and create jobs.</li></ol></li><li>2. Exportation of cattle can be proceed if:<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>a. the domestic demand of meat has been adequately fulfilled by locally produced beef;</li><li>b. cattle population in the country has sufficiently supplied national demand of beef.</li></ol></li><li>3. Importation of slaughter livestock and exportation of cattle must meet the administrative and technical requirements as stipulates in this regulation.</li></ol>
